US 441 UTILITY RELOCATIONS

Sealed Bids for the construction of US 441 Utility Relocations project will be received by the City of Mount Dora, at the Purchasing Office, 510 N. Baker Street, Mount Dora, Florida, 32757, until 2:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, December 13, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of constructing approximately 4,400 LF of 16" PVC water main, 5,500 LF of 16" reclaim main, 3,200 LF of 12" PVC force main, 1,200 LF of 16" PVC force main, and will include 2,300 LF of horizontal directional drill, 900 LF of jack and bore crossings plus all associated valves, fittings, hydrants, ARV's, service connections, asphalt repair and property restoration.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office, Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays), and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the Purchasing Office, 510 N. Baker Street, Mount Dora, Florida, 32757, Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (excluding Holidays).

Bidding Documents will be provided on compact disc as portable document format (PDF) files and as printed Bidding Documents (one of each), for a non-refundable charge of \$250 per set, payable to "Mittauer & Associates, Inc." Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, the digital and printed Bidding Documents will be sent via UPS Ground. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 900 N. Donnelly Street (Public Works Department). Attendance at the pre-bid conference is mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

In accordance with F.S. 218.77 (Florida Prompt Payment Act), this project may be paid for in full or part using federal funds distributed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection State Revolving Fund (SRF). Payment is contingent on receipt of federal funds or federal approval.

To be considered qualified, Bidder shall be licensed to engage in the business of contracting in the State of Florida by the Construction Industry Licensing Board and shall have successfully completed, as prime contractor, a minimum of (3 to 5) projects of a similar nature within the past (3 to 5) years each having a minimum contract value of \$2,000,000.
