Sealed bids for the construction of the SRWMD Cost Share – Lift Station Rehabilitation project will be received by the City of Waldo, 14655 Kennard Street, Waldo, Florida 32694, until 2:00 p.m. local time on November 1, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of rehabilitating two (2) existing duplex sewage pump stations by installing new suction and discharge piping, new control panels, lining of wetwells, bypass pumping, associated electrical, and sitework. Work also includes removal and replacement of an existing submersible well pump at the City's Water Treatment Plant.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office, Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays), and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents will be provided on compact disc as portable document format (PDF) files and as printed Bidding Documents (one of each), for a non-refundable charge of \$120.00 per set, payable to "Mittauer & Associates, Inc." Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, the digital and printed Bidding Documents will be sent via UPS Ground. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

To be considered qualified, Bidder shall be licensed to engage in the business of contracting in the State of Florida by the Construction Industry Licensing Board and shall have successfully completed, as prime contractor, a minimum of three (3) projects of a similar nature involving submersible sewage pump stations within the past five (5) years, each having a minimum contract value of at least \$100,000.
